# 7<sup>th</sup> Grade School Supply List: 2014-2015

Welcome to 7<sup>th</sup> grade, class of 2020! Here are the supplies you'll need in the fall. Please try and buy them before the first day of school. Look for sales over the summer, especially for the folders (*Staples* usually sells them for 10 cents each in August). Please be sure that the folders have the fasteners in the middle to hold 3-hole punched papers. If you have a difficult time buying supplies, notify one of your teachers when school starts. USB flash drive to save work in computer labs

3 packs of index cards (to make flashcards for vocabulary terms)

College-ruled loose leaf paper

Protractor
